Our Rangers and Rovers mate have participated Yoga on the occasion of International Yoga day celebrated on 21st June 2022 in the college.

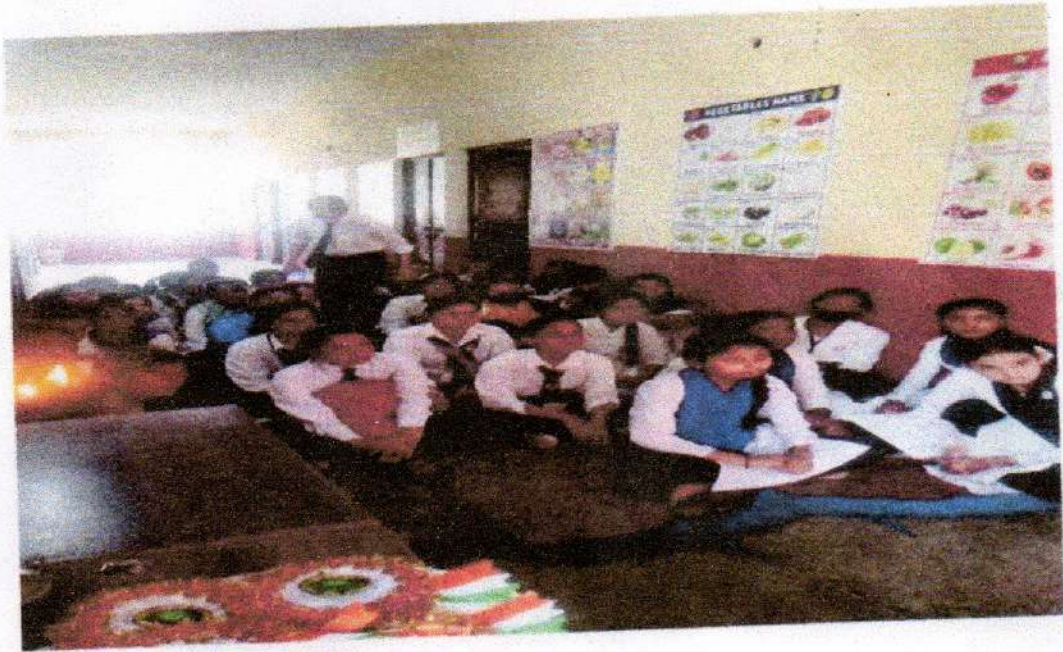
On behalf of 75th Independence day Celebration Our Rangers and Rovers mate have participated in 'Har ghar tiranga' rally on 12/8/2022.
