ANALYSIS REPORT ON THE STUDENT'S FEEDBACK RECEIVED (2018-19)

- 1. To get the best result the College needs to complete the syllabus of the course in time.
- 2. There should be an arrangement of class in the teacher's absence.
- 3. Need to inspire students for ethical conduct.
- 4. To help the students providing textbooks, reference books, etc. should be made available from the library.
- 5. There should be proper arrangements for teaching aids (OHP/ Blackboards/PPTs) on the college campus.
- 6. During the analysis of the student's feedback, It was noticed that majority of students have responded that the syllabus is creating interest in them. There is a scope for the teachers to create interest among the students in the syllabus, as around 12% of students were not seen as interested.
- 7. Time allotment for the interaction of students to get clarified their doubts and to boost their confidence. It was observed that More than 80% of students feel that the teachers have given them a good time for interactions. It is recommended to the teachers to give sufficient time for more interaction.
- 8. It was observed that over 91% of students feel the overall effectiveness of the teacher was good. There is a scope for further improvement here and hence it is recommended to the teachers enhance their overall effectiveness.
